

CASE STUDY: LIVING ROOM

Every detail in this stunning contemporary living room is being accentuated with the help of different layers of light.

Uplights decorate the walls by sending shafts of light towards the ceiling. Warm white LED strips create a soft glow resonating from the joinery, behind the television screen and down from the ceiling. LED downlights focus beams of light on specific features in the room accentuating their details.



Lucca uplights are used to skim narrow beams of light up the walls. These can be dimmed to create a subtle night time effect.





Contour^{HD24} backlights the joinery, creating another feature in the room. Adding strip to the coffers and blinds adds another layer of lighting.





Specific details, such as the flowers and the coffee table, are pinspotted using the low glare Polespring LED downlight.





CASE STUDY: KITCHEN

Clever lighting effects add drama to this contemporary family kitchen, a space filled with natural light during the day. Discreet lighting is incorporated throughout the multi-purpose room to enhance individual features.

See below how the space is lit with just downlights. It is only with the addition of the layered feature lighting in the image opposite that the space truly comes alive. The exterior swimming pool courtyard is also lit extending the feeling of space by drawing the eye outside.



Square Double Trimless downlights provide task lighting to the island and add drama to the centre of the dining tables.




Etta and Etta Eyelid under cupboard lights illuminate the shelving above the sink and backlight the onyx sculpture.





Contour^{HD24} is used to create a floating effect under the kitchen island, a soft glow behind the banquette and a strong linear effect in the skylight.





CASE STUDY: LANDSCAPE

Lighting has the ability to seamlessly combine your inside with the outside, allowing you to enjoy your garden throughout the year.

This contemporary landscape has been transformed into an oasis with the use of lighting. Each tree has become a feature with the help of cleverly placed spotlights, which can be re-spiked as the planting grows. Light over the planting illuminates both colour and texture bringing the garden to life.



Lucca Externals uplight the windows to accentuate the texture of the brick work adding depth from both inside and out.




High powered Kensington Spotlights illuminate the tree trunks and foliage, creating a spectacular vista down the garden.



On the left, a heron sculpture is cross lit using two Kew Spotlights, drawing your eye to the end of the garden.







CASE STUDY: SPA

The lighting for Weavers' House Spa at the Swan Hotel in Suffolk was designed for the clients' total relaxation, well-being and comfort. The lighting design and discreet products used throughout the spa create a truly intimate calm experience for the user.

For the spa lobby, we have enhanced the products to show them off in their best light.



Contour^{HD24} is cleverly concealed behind the joinery to enhance the retail products and create a soft glow behind and to front light the niches to the side.




The low glare Etta Eyelid is used to highlight the top of each of the niches to provide a uniformity to the shelving.



The discreet Polespring LED downlight washes light down the front of the retail units as well as providing a soft focus to the central table.




HOSPITALITY

It's not just the home that benefits from a clever lighting design. Public spaces need excellent lighting in order to showcase the services on offer and draw customers inside.

Bars, hotels and spas need soft lighting to create an intimate environment whilst still being functional in key areas, such as a table in a restaurant or products on a shelf. Showrooms need to be able to present their products in the most flattering light possible, whilst still creating a bright and welcoming environment.










MARINE

We have a range of miniature fittings requiring minimal recess space to ensure you retain as much ceiling height within the superyacht as possible.

Natural light is minimal on lower decks so light your joinery in order to create a window in the space. A layered lighting scheme will maximise the space and add impact.

Minimalisation is key as space is tight and the ceilings are low. Keep the fittings small and discreet for optimum effect.











CHALETS

With the darker wooden surfaces of a chalet, the key is to ensure there is enough light when required, whilst still leaving the space feeling atmospheric. Consider emphasising the texture of the timber with light to add a whole different dimension to the space.

A layering of downlights, uplights and lamps create a cosy environment. Conceal spotlights between beams to wash light down beams or onto surfaces below. Place uplights either side of a fireplace, turning it into a feature even when it is not lit. Add lighting to any shelving to create an intimate glow at night.

HALLS & STAIRS

Halls and staircases can be narrow and dull, yet they create the first impression and set the tone for the rest of the house. Create impact with an oversized decorative pendant that can be dimmed to create mood. Add layered lighting effects to give the drama to the space.

Staircases are very much the central spine of a home. With great lighting design, they can become interesting architectural features. Consider adding individual stair lights to make them feel special by placing a low level floor washer on every other step. This works especially well on stairs leading to basements when it is not possible to recess fittings into the sloped ceiling above.

LIVING ROOMS

As a key entertaining space, a living room requires considered lighting in order to create the right atmosphere. Before making any decisions on the lighting, work out exactly where the furniture will be positioned and what focal points you want to highlight.

A layered lighting effect works best. Consider integrating lighting into any joinery to highlight books or objects. Paintings, furniture, sculptures or other works of art can each be accentuated using perfectly positioned downlights and spotlights. Highlight a coffee table with a narrow beam of light to create a soft focus in the centre of the room.

KITCHENS

The kitchen is the heart of the home, often working as a multi-functional dining, living and working area. The best way to maximise these different functions throughout the day is with a clever lighting scheme and flexible lighting control. This ensures a well connected space that the whole family can enjoy.

Ensure the kitchen lighting is dimmable as this allows the space to go from bright and practical to moody and atmospheric at the touch of a button.

BEDROOMS

Good lighting can transform a bedroom from practical in the morning, to an atmospheric sanctuary ideal for relaxing in the evening.

Using reflected lighting is essential when creating a calming environment. By using reflected lighting from downlights onto wardrobes and curtains, the room feels instantly softer. Consider adding table lamps or reading lights for soft local lighting by the bedside and on a dressing table.











BATHROOMS

Use the lighting as creatively as possible to enrich the space, the function and the mood.










LANDSCAPE
